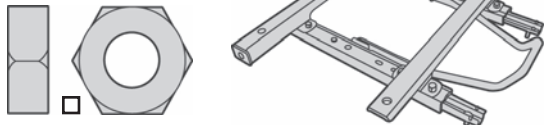

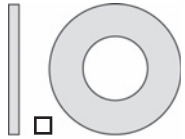
Seat Slider with Adapter (51245 shown), Qty - 1



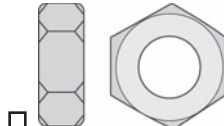
8mm Nut, Qty - 6



8mm Washer, Qty - 6



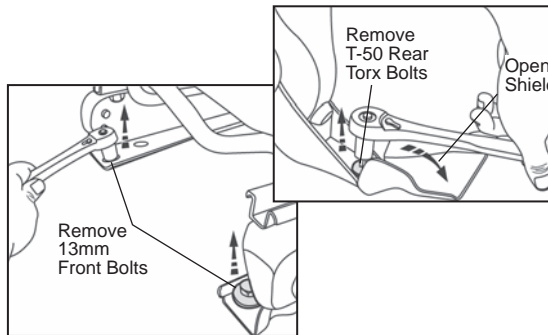
12mm Washer, Qty - 1

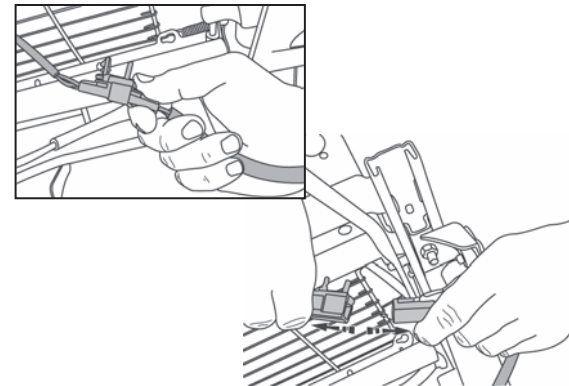
## 1 Remove Seat from Vehicle

Use a 13mm wrench to remove the front bolts securing the seat to the vehicle. Open the plastic shield over the rear bolts and use a T-50 Torx to remove them. Set the bolts aside to be reused.



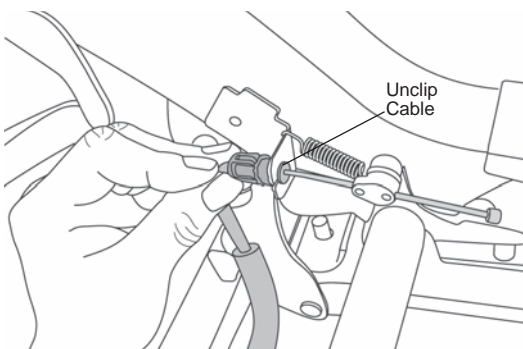
## 2 Unplug Seatbelt Sensor

Unplug the seatbelt sensor wire. Remove seat from vehicle.



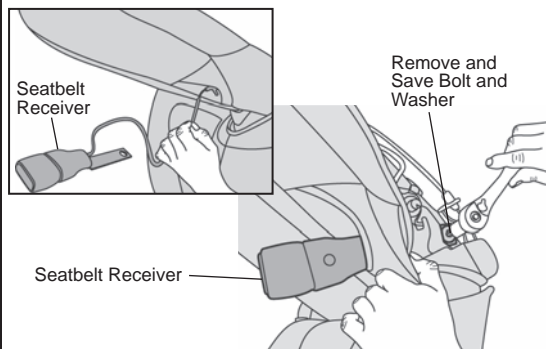
## 3 Release Fold and Tumble Cable

Unclip the fold and tumble cable from the O.E. Seat Riser.



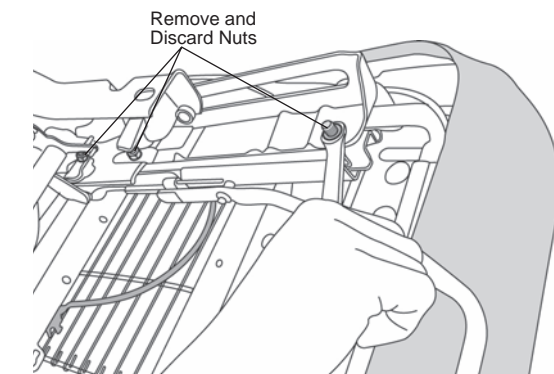
## 4 Remove Seatbelt Receiver

Use a T-50 Torx to remove the O.E. seatbelt receiver from the O.E. Seat. Save the bolt and washer to be reused later.



## 5 Remove the O.E. Seat and Slider from the Riser

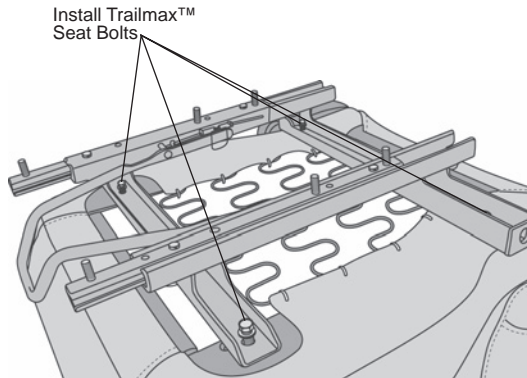
Use a 13mm wrench to remove the O.E. Seat and Slider from the O.E. Seat Riser. Discard the six (6) nuts.



## Seat Slider with Adapter Installation Instructions

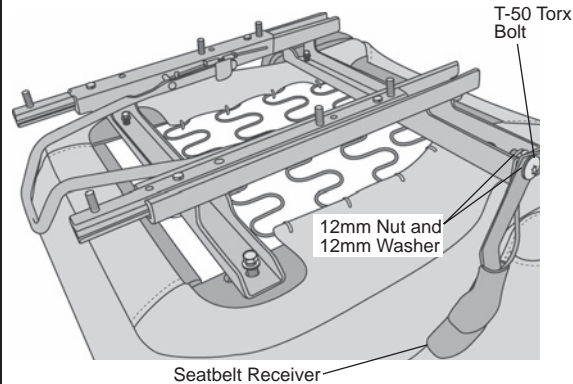
### 6 Install Seat Slider on Trailmax™ Seat

Use the bolts that came with your Trailmax™ Seat to install the Slider on the seat.



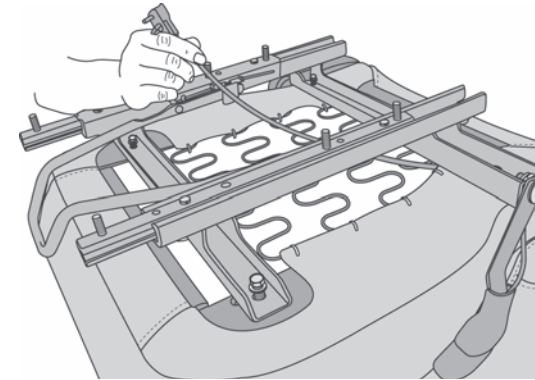
### 7 Reinstall the Seatbelt Receiver

Use the Torx bolt removed in Step 4 with a 12mm Washer and 12mm Nut to mount the Seatbelt Receiver to the Seat Slider with Adapter.



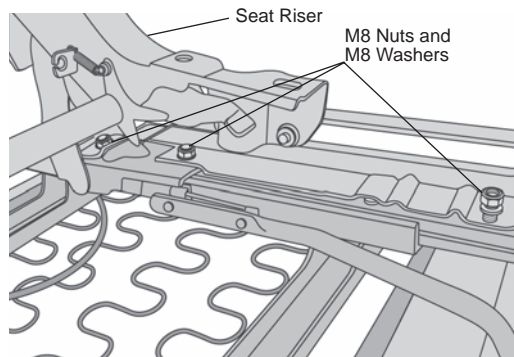
### 8 Clear Seatbelt Sensor Wire

Pull the seatbelt sensor wire through so it does not interfere with the seat installation.



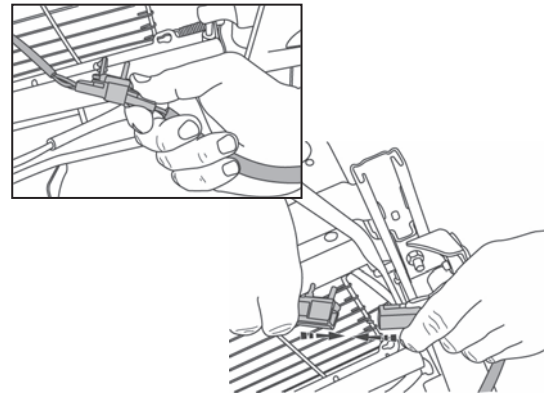
### 9 Install Seat and Slider Assembly to Seat Riser

Use the M8 Nuts and M8 Washers to mount the Trailmax™ Seat and Slider Assembly to the Seat Riser.



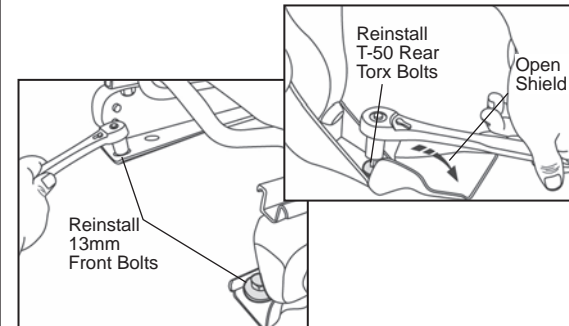
### 10 Reattach Seatbelt Sensor Wire

Place the seat back in the vehicle.  
Plug in the seatbelt sensor wire.



### 11 Reinstall Seat in Vehicle

Use a 13mm wrench to reinstall the front bolts securing the seat to the vehicle. Use a T-50 Torx to reinstall the rear bolts.



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
