



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


TrekStep™ – Installation Instructions





Locate Rear Bumper Attachment

Locate the rear bumper attachment point on the driver's side of the vehicle.




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2 Remove Rear Bumper Fasteners

Completely remove and discard the bumper fasteners.

On some vehicles with towing packages, you will need to remove the bolts from the bumper bracket. Set these bolts aside to be reused later.



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Before installing fasteners apply 2 drops of loctite.



Assemble Linkage to Mounting Bracket

Assemble the Mounting Bracket to the Linkage.

2500 & 3500 HD 2007 - 2010 Vehicles:


Use the M10-1.5 x 35 Socket Cap Screws. Do not use a Spacer.

2500 & 3500 HD 2011 Vehicles:

Use the M10-1.5 x 110 Socket Cap Screws and the Large Spacer.

1500 2007 - Current Vehicles:

Use M10-1.5 x 80 Socket Cap Partial Thread Screws and the Small Spacer.




4 Install Linkage Assembly

Use the M14 Hex Bolts to mount the Linkage to the frame. Secure the bolts to the frame with 9/16" Washers and M14 Nylock Nuts.


If your vehicle has the tow package, reinstall the bolts that were removed in Step 2.

On some vehicles it may be necessary to loosen the bumper bracket to slide the M14 Hex Bolt through the top hole.




5 Install Step

Use the M6-1.0 x 20 Socket Head Cap Screws to mount the Step to the Linkage Assembly.



6 Adjust Step

Adjust the Step from side to side. Make sure to leave clearance for foot access to lower step. Tighten the allen head bolts.



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TrekStep™ – Installation Instructions

Operation

- The TrekStep[™] is foot operated and deploys and retracts with a nudge of your foot.
- To deploy, press down using your left foot, on the forward outside corner of the step pad.
- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
- Max Load Capacity: 300 lbs.
- Always use appropriate hand holds when stepping up to or down from your truck's cargo bed.

Care and Maintenance

The step pad surface and linkage arms should be washed with mild soap and water using a soft brush or sponge to dislodge any mud, dirt or accumulated road grime. Rinse with fresh water. After it is dry, lubricate the hinge with 3-IN-ONE Oil.

To prevent slipping, avoid applying waxes, lubricants or protectants like Armor All® to the step surface.
